

**THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY
IN THE CITY OF VINITA DUE TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

WHEREAS, Chuck Hoskin, Mayor of the City of Vinita, Oklahoma has heretofore, on the 20th day of March, 2020, entered a Public Declaration of a State of Emergency in the City of Vinita, Oklahoma and on March 23, 2020, entered a Second Supplemental Declaration of Emergency and on March 25, 2020 entered a Third Supplemental Declaration of emergency due to the COVID- 19 pandemic, and;

WHEREAS, the circumstances which warranted the initial and Supplemental Declarations of Emergency by Mayor Hoskin have only become more serious and dire since the initial and Supplemental Declarations of Emergency were entered, and;

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Department of Health notified the Mayor's office on March 25, 2020 that there is now one confirmed case of Covid-19 in a Craig County resident, and;

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that a state of emergency now exists in the entirety of the City of Vinita, Oklahoma; that during the existence of this state of emergency, the **EXECUTIVE MEMORANDUM 2020-01** issued by Governor Stitt of the State of Oklahoma on March 24, 2020 shall be operative in the City of Vinita, Oklahoma as the City is situated within a county experiencing community spread of Covid-19, to-wit

"And, on March 24, 2020, I issued the Fourth Amended Executive Order 2020-07. Paragraph 20 of the Fourth Amended Executive Order 2020-07 ordered all businesses not identified as being within a critical infrastructure sector as defined by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (USDHS) and located in a county experiencing community spread of COVID-19, as identified by OSDH on its website, to close."

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED that this Third Supplemental Declaration shall continue in full force and effect until the issuance by Mayor of the City of Vinita of a proclamation declaring its termination.
